Impact of Road & Bus Route Changes in the Senja Area from 3 April

As mentioned in the letter to parents issued on 21 March, parts of Senja Road and Senja Link will be converted to one-way traffic from 3 April 2022. Please refer to the letter issued then for the changes. As a result, at the instruction of Land Transport Authority (LTA), our school gate located at Senja Road will be permanently closed to mitigate safety concerns and to facilitate a smoother traffic flow.

From 4 April (Monday) onwards, we will only open the school gate located at Bukit Panjang Ring Road for vehicles entering and leaving our school. Parents/Guardians can choose to drop their children at the drop-off point along Bukit Panjang Ring Road or inside the school compound.

As traffic inside the school is now two-way, all vehicles that drive into the school compound via Bukit Panjang Ring Road will need to go to the roundabout (**see map layout**), make a round turn, and drop their children **only in front of the foyer of the General Office**, before exiting at Bukit Panjang Ring Road. Please do not drop your children at any other spot of the school for their own safety. We also appeal to all drivers to drive slowly (no more than 15km/hour), and pay more attention at the zebra crossing inside the school.

Where possible, we would like to encourage parents/guardians to let their children come to school by foot or via public transport on their own to inculcate greater responsibility and independence.

Mask-wearing requirements from 29 March

In line with the government's announcement of the easing of some Safe Management Measures from 29 March onwards, in particular, mask-wearing in outdoor and indoor places, I have communicated with all students this morning via morning assembly on the mask-wearing requirements both in public areas and within school. Mask-wearing will continue to be compulsory in indoor places such as classrooms, library and hall as there is still the risk of transmission of Covid-19. For outdoor places such as school field and corridors, mask-wearing would be optional. However, though not compulsory, I assure students that it is fine to continue to wear their masks in these places to protect their own health as well as others. I also encourage students to continue the good practices built over the years such as wipe-down routine and monitoring their own health, for example, not coming to school if they are unwell.

With your understanding and cooperation on the above matters, we are confident Zhenghua Secondary School will remain a safe and conducive school for all.
