Dear Parents / Guardians,

It has been 3 weeks since the start of the school year, and I trust that your child/ward has settled in well in the new school year. In my first address to the students, I encouraged all students to search for 3 things this year – search for opportunities, control and inspiration. There is a plethora of learning opportunities for every Zhenghuarian to look forward to, not just in the classroom but also in the various student development activities. For example, we are proud of our Student Leaders who had successfully organised this year's Sec 1 Orientation amidst the challenges posed by Covid-19, to help the Sec 1s integrate in the Zhenghua family. I also encouraged the students to look for control of their time, and more importantly, their energy. Lastly, I challenged them to look to their seniors for inspiration.

GCE O Level Results

On that note, I am pleased to share with you that the 2021 cohort did well. 52% of the Sec 4 Express students qualify for Junior Colleges, and 95% Polytechnics. The following subjects also achieved 100% passes – (Sec 4 Express) Pure Chemistry, Pure Biology, Higher Chinese and Malay; (Sec 5 Normal) Design & Technology, Chinese and Malay. Thirteen of our Sec 4 Express students obtained a score of 12 points or less for English and 5 other subjects, while four Sec 5 Normal students achieved a score of 15 points or less for English and 4 other subjects. We are proud of our students, and I would like to express my appreciation to the staff of the school and parents/guardians for teaching and guiding the students.

Assessment Matters

You will find the assessment plan for all examinable subjects in the year ahead for your child/ward's level in this letter. Sec 1 and 3 students will not be sitting for the Mid-Year Examinations in Semester 1. Instead, they will be assessed through class/level tests and alternative forms of assessment like Project Work. As mentioned in our first letter to parents, Common Test 1 for Sec 4 and 5 will be conducted from 18 – 25 February. Lessons will

carry on as per the timetable for the other levels, and for the Sec 4 and 5s, lessons will resume beyond the time set aside for the Common Test. The detailed breakdown of the weightings for the various assessments that your child/ward will be sitting for in 2022 can be found in Annex A.

We appreciate your assistance in ensuring that your child/ward put in the required effort for the various components that they will be assessed on. Please note that students who are absent from any assessments/paper or a component paper of a subject must produce a medical certificate the following day, failing which, students will be deemed as absent without a valid reason and no marks will be given for the paper.

Lastly, on behalf of the school, we would like to wish all who are celebrating Chinese New Year a joyful and healthy year ahead!
